Adventures in California's Aquaculture Extension during the COVID Pandemic



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A great number of challenges threatened the integrity of California's Aquaculture community during the COVID Pandemic. Aquaculture extension was involved in a variety of activities early in the pandemic such as surveying the industries needs for the state and federal government as California's restaurants and processors experienced a public health shutdown. A variety of research needs became apparent during this period such as food security and environmental challenges brought on by climate change. This talk will discuss a number of research directions for UC Davis Aquaculture extension in hydroponic plant production, food science in the processing of freshwater finfish and marine conservation aquaculture.
